WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A.* 18A:38-1 *et seq.* requires that the Springfield Public School District provide a free public education to all students ages 5 through 20 who are domiciled within the district; and

WHEREAS, Ms. B alleged that her daughter, 2513, resides in Springfield, New Jersey with her aunt, Ms. M, who is supporting 2513 gratis during the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 18A:38-1 *et seq.*, the Springfield Board of Education (the "Board") provided 2513 with a free public education during the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, it was brought to the attention of Mr. Michael Davino, the Superintendent of Schools, that 2513 did not reside in Springfield, New Jersey, but resided in Union, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in March 2016, Mr. Davino commissioned Mr. James Post, a residency investigator, to investigate whether 2513 resided in Springfield, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2016, Mr. Post reported that he conducted a residency investigation, which concluded that 2513, in fact, resided in Union, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, based on the evidence accumulated by the district and the result of the investigation, Mr. Davino determined that 2513 did not reside in Springfield and made an application to the Board for the removal of 2513 from Springfield Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2016, Mr. Davino provided Ms. B as well as Ms. M with written notification of the investigation results and informed them of their right to request a hearing before the Board to refute the finding that 2513 no longer resides in Springfield, New Jersey, and thus is ineligible for a free public education within the Springfield Public School District; and

WHEREAS, a residency hearing was held before the Board on May 9, 2016; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:38-1 and *N.J.A.C.* 6A:22-4.3, the Board considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board determined that there was insufficient evidence to establish that 2513 is presently domiciled in Springfield, New Jersey.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Springfield Board of Education, by recorded roll call vote of the majority, has determined that 2513 does not reside in Springfield; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that 2513 will be entitled to remain enrolled within the district during the pendency of any appeal filed by Ms. B and/or Ms. M; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board Secretary is authorized to prepare, with the assistance of the Board Attorneys, the necessary Notice of Final Ineligibility to inform Ms. B of the Board's decision to remove 2513 from the district.

WHEREAS, Ms. A alleged that her daughter, 0614 resides in Springfield, New Jersey with her guardian and uncle, Mr. A, who is supporting 0614 gratis during the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with *N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1 et seq.*, the Springfield Board of Education (the "Board") provided 0614 with a free public education during the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, it was brought to the attention of Mr. Michael Davino, the Superintendent of Schools, that 0614 did not reside in Springfield, New Jersey, but resided in the Union/Elizabeth area; and

WHEREAS, in April 2016, Mr. Davino commissioned Mr. James Post, a residency investigator, to investigate whether 0614 resided in Springfield, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in April 2016, Mr. Post reported that he conducted a residency investigation, which concluded that 0614, in fact, did not reside in Springfield, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, based on the evidence accumulated by the district and the result of the investigation, Mr. Davino determined that 0614 did not reside in Springfield and made an application to the Board for the removal of 0614 from Springfield Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2016, Mr. Davino provided Ms. A as well as Mr. A. with written notification of the investigation results and informed them of their right to request a hearing before the Board to refute the finding that 0614 no longer resides in Springfield, New Jersey, and thus is ineligible for a free public education within the Springfield Public School District; and

WHEREAS, Mr. A contacted Springfield administration on or about April 29, 2016 to request said hearing; and

WHEREAS, a residency hearing was held before the Board on May 9, 2016; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1* and *N.J.A.C. 6A:22-4.3*, the Board considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board determined that there was sufficient evidence to establish that 0614 is presently domiciled in Springfield, New Jersey.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Springfield Board of Education, by recorded roll call vote of the majority, has determined that 0614 currently resides in Springfield.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that 0614 will be entitled to remain enrolled within the district.

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1 et seq., the Springfield Board of Education (the "Board") provided 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t with a free public education during the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, it was brought to the attention of Mr. Michael Davino, the Superintendent of Schools, that Ms. W, 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t did not reside in Springfield, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in April 2016, Mr. Davino commissioned Mr. James Post, a residency investigator, to investigate whether Ms. W, 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t resided in Springfield, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2016, Mr. Post reported that he conducted a residency investigation, which concluded that Ms. W, 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t, in fact, did not reside in Springfield, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, based on the evidence accumulated by the district and the result of the investigation, Mr. Davino determined that Ms. W, 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t do not reside in Springfield and made an application to the Board for the removal of 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t from Springfield Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2016, Mr. Davino provided Ms. W with written notification of the investigation results and informed her of her right to request a hearing before the Board to refute the findings that 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t no longer reside in Springfield, New Jersey, and thus are ineligible for a free public education within the Springfield Public School District; and

WHEREAS, a residency hearing was held before the Board on May 9, 2016; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1 and N.J.A.C. 6A:22-4.3, the Board considered all of the evidence presented during the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board determined that there was sufficient evidence to establish that Ms. W, 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t are presently homeless as defined by NJAC 6A:17-1.2 and 2.2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Springfield Board of Education, by recorded roll call vote of the majority, has determined that 2805l, 2805s, and 2805t will be entitled to remain enrolled within the district consistent with State and Federal Law.
