Congratulations to Samantha Sainato, grade 4 student, who was the winner of the SSEP Mission 13 patch contest.

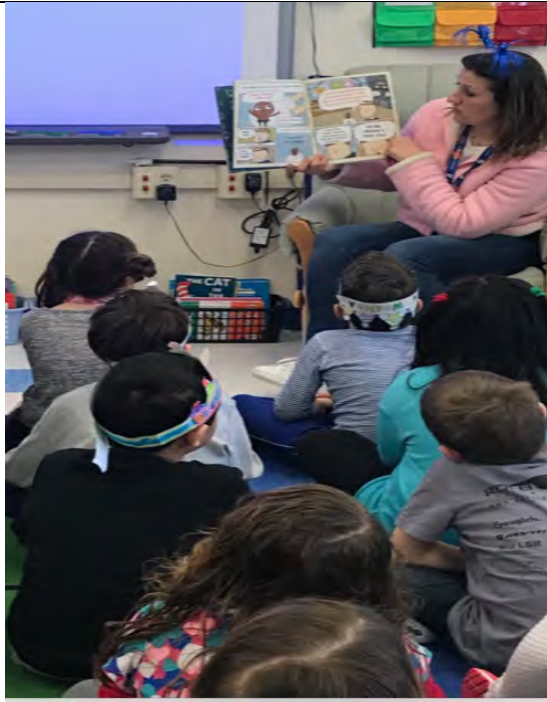
