The sports physical (whether from your private doctor or the school physician) is valid for 365 days and will expire on the anniversary date of the exam. Check your records with Mrs. Graham to see if you need a new physical. You must complete the pre-participation history and submit it to the health office as soon as possible prior to the school doctor visit in order for the school physician to examine you. Your parent must also register you for SPRING 2020 on the Family ID website. Follow the links found on the school website. **ALL JUNIORS MUST REPEAT AN IMPACT TEST THIS YEAR (IF NOT YET DONE IN THE FALL). ANY NEW ATHLETE MUST COMPLETE IMPACT TEST FOR CONCUSSION ONLINE.
