This dialogue should include a role- play exchange between a teacher &amp; a student.</p>	<p><b><u>Collage:</u></b> Create a poster collage of <b><u>3-5 activities</u></b> that you like <b><u>to do</u></b> and <b><u>3-5</u></b> things that you <b><u>don't like to do.</u></b> The paper should be no bigger than an 8X10 sheet of construction paper. One side should be "J'aime"and the other side should be "Je n'aime pas" All sentences should be in French.</p>
<p><b><u>Cartoon Character:</u></b> Create a cartoon character. Give the character a name. Include 3 physical descriptions and 3 personality descriptions. Remember to use adjectives agreement for genders.</p>	<p><b><u>Weather Report:</u></b> Write the weather report for an entire week in French, (either in July or August) also write the full date in French for every day of the week you are referring to.</p>	<p><b><u>All About Me:</u></b> Write a short paragraph about yourself in French. Include the following information, your name, 3 personality traits, and 3 physical descriptions. Attach a picture of yourself onto the document.</p>
