Must -Do Activities:

- **Reading Assignment:** Read one fiction and one non-fiction book and complete a writing assignment for each book (posted on the James Caldwell Elementary School website on the Summer Assignments page).

- **IXL.com Math Activities:**

Spend at least *one hour* OR *score 80 points* on *EACH* of the following skills:

- Fourth Grade Skill: A.3 Place Value Names
- Fourth Grade Skill: D.1 Multiplication Facts to 12
- Fourth Grade Skill: F.1 Add, Subtract, Multiply, Divide
- Fourth Grade Skill: Q.9 Add and Subtract Fractions with like denominators
- Fourth Grade Skill: X.9 Classify quadrilaterals

Follow these steps to access your math assignment:

1. Go to www.clever.com, our single sign-in portal.
2. Click on "Log in as a student" in the upper right corner.
3. Type in James Caldwell Elementary School in the "Search for your school" bar.
4. Log in with your username and password.
5. Open the "IXL" application.
