As the school year comes to a close, we realize that you are looking forward to sunny days and relaxation.

However, we also realize that students need to keep academic skills fresh for the next school year, and we want our students to have a smooth transition to 4th grade. We have created math and reading assignments for you to complete before you enter the next grade. Think about pacing yourself so you are not overwhelmed.

Must -Do Activities:

- **Reading Assignment:** Read one fiction and one non-fiction book and complete a post reading activity for each book (posted on the TLS website on the Summer Assignments page).

- **IXL Math Activities:**
Earn a Smart Score of at least 80% or higher on *EACH* of the following skills:
(Note: there are both third and fourth grade skills listed)
 - Third Grade Skill: Estimation and Rounding - Choose at least **2** skills from P.1-P.16 that you have not previously mastered (80% or higher)
 - Third Grade Skill: Addition - C.1 Add two numbers up to three digits
 - Third Grade Skill: Subtraction - D.1 Subtract numbers up to three digits
 - Fourth Grade Skill: Number Sense - A.7 Writing numbers up to 1,000 in words: convert words to digits
 - Fourth Grade Skill: Number Sense - A.8 Writing numbers up to 1,000 in words: convert digits to words
 - Fourth Grade Skill: D.1 Multiplication Facts to 10

Follow these steps to access your math assignment:

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1. Go to www.clever.com, our single sign-in portal.
2. Click on “Log in as a student” in the upper right corner.
3. Type in *Thelma L. Sandmeier Elementary School* in the “Search for your school” bar.
4. Log in with your username and password.
5. Open the “IXL” application.
