3. EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

Moved by Mr. Silverstein, seconded by Mr. Munoz, approval of the resolution regarding emergency regulations:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs enacted emergency regulations that require public bodies (e.g., municipalities, boards of education, etc.) to meet certain criteria if the public body is holding a remote public meeting during a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Springfield Board of Education ("Board") is required by the aforementioned regulations to adopt procedures for public comment made during remote meetings during a state of emergency.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

1. The Board Secretary shall announce publicly, and shall cause to be entered in the minutes of the meeting, an accurate statement to the effect that either: (1) both adequate and electronic notice of the meeting has been provided, specifying the time, place, and manner in which such notice was provided; or (2) only electronic notice of the meeting has been provided, specifying the time, place, and manner in which such notice was provided, and that discussion and effectuation of public business shall be limited to the matters included in *N.J.A.C. 5:39-1.5(g)*;
 2. In the event the Board conducts a remote meeting during a state of emergency, the Board shall allow members of the public to make comments via audio or audio and video. Individuals will be prompted to enter their name and address in the Q&A function, and the Board shall hear the comments in the order received. All of the Board's Policies and Regulations related to public participation in board meetings shall remain in effect, including, but not limited to, the presiding officer's ability to limit each statement made by a participant to a 3 minute duration;
 3. If a member of the public becomes disruptive during any portion of the remote public meeting, the Board President shall mute, or direct appropriate staff to mute, the disruptive member of the public. The disruptive individual shall receive a warning that continued disruption may result in the individual being removed from the remote meeting or muted at future remote meetings. Disruptive conduct includes, but is not limited to, shouting, interruption, or use of profanity. If time permits, the Board may allow the disruptive individual to make a public comment at the conclusion of the public comment portion, but reserves the right to continue muting or remove the disruptive individual if the disruptive behavior persists.
 4. These procedures and requirements for making public comment, along with an explanation of the audio muting function of the electronic communications platform being used, shall be announced by the Board President at the beginning of each remote public meeting during a state of emergency.

**Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement
2021-2022**

WHEREAS, the Springfield Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel only, an annual school year threshold of \$150 per staff member where prior Board approval shall not be required unless this annual threshold for a staff member is exceeded in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

WHEREAS, travel and related expenses not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7, but deemed by the Board of Education to be necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out of District Travel and Reimbursement Forms; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves all travel not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 as being necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out of District Travel and Reimbursement Forms; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7, to a maximum expenditure of \$61,293.00 for all staff and board members.

**Sidebar Agreement between the
Springfield Education Association and the
Springfield Board of Education**

Both parties enter into this Sidebar Agreement on _____.

This Sidebar is intended to delineate the parameters for coaching stipends. This agreement shall be in effect during the 2020-2021 academic year and for the time specified by legislative action or Executive Order and only in times of health-related or other crisis necessitating the cancelling of sport seasons or closing of the physical school structures for the health and safety of the students, staff and community at-large.

Coaching Stipends

A. Appointments

1. For the purpose of coaching stipends, each season for the 2020-21 academic year shall be divided into three (3) phases as established by the NJSIAA.
2. Beginning on the date that this Sidebar Agreement is ratified by both parties, the Board of Education shall appoint individuals for positions prior to each third with the understanding that upon recommendation of the Superintendent the same individual(s) shall be appointed for the duration of the entire season.

B. Schedule

1. JDHS Spring Sports - Season 4. (Boys Tennis, Golf, All other Spring Sports)
 - a. Phase 1: March 22 to April 19
 - b. Phase 2: April 20 to May 21
 - c. Phase 3: May 22 to End of Season
2. FMG Spring Sports - Season 4. (Baseball and Softball)
 - a. Phase 1: April 12 to April 27
 - b. Phase 2: April 28 to May 14
 - c. Phase 3: May 15 to End of Season

C. Payment

1. Stipends shall be divided into equal thirds. Coaches shall be paid one third of the seasonal stipend for each phase for which they are appointed.
2. Following the guidance of the State Department of Health and the New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association, should a season be cancelled, coaches will be paid the full stipend for the phase in which they were appointed.

D. Miscellaneous

1. NJSIAA guidelines as to screening, etc. will be adhered to and such screening shall be performed by district staff including, but not limited to the trainer, coach and/or school nurse.

2. The specification of “seasons” are made by the NJSIAA. The district will apply the “phases” to any additional “seasons” or shifts made by the NJSIAA guidelines.
