WHEREAS, following the second advertisement for bids, there was a protest filed by a representative of AstroTurf; and

WHEREAS, said challenge lacked any legal or factual basis, as the bid specifications were fully compliant with the law; and

WHEREAS, the Board held the second bid opening on August 21, 2012, and the apparent low bidder was Rochelle Contracting Co., Inc.; and

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WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Rochelle Contracting Co., Inc. is fully responsive to the specifications, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the challenge by AstroTurf be and hereby is rejected; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a contract for the project shall be awarded to Rochelle Contracting Co., Inc.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon consultation with Board counsel and the Board engineer, the Business Administrator be and hereby is authorized to take any and all action to commence a contract with Rochelle Contracting Co., Inc.
